Let me start off with an illustration from a Peanuts cartoon strip. Perhaps you've seen or heard it before.

Charlie Brown is standing at Lucy's booth, which is marked with the sign "Psychiatric Help – 10¢" Lucy says to Charlie Brown, "Maybe I can put it another way ... life is like a deck chair." "Like a what?" asks Charlie Brown. Lu-

cy explains, "Have you ever been on a cruise ship? Passengers open up these canvas deck chairs so they can sit in the sun. Some people place their chairs facing the rear of the ship so they can see where they've been. Other people face their chairs forward – they want to see where they're going.

On the cruise ship of life, which way is your deck chair facing?"

Charlie Brown's response: **"I've never been able to get one unfolded."**

How many of us have experienced just the same thing that Charlie Brown has? Possibly there have been days, weeks, months, maybe even years, that you just can't seem to "get your chair unfolded?" With all the commitments in life, church, family, work, relationships, on and on we could go. You would have to agree, life can certainly be challenging at times.

If this describes your life at times, here are a few thoughts of encouragement.

First, we need to be thankful we're on the cruise ship at all, amen? Yes, there will be days when we just can't seem to get it together, but that doesn't mean we can't be thankful for what God has allowed us to enjoy.

Secondly, if you can't get your chair unfolded, ask for help. God has made us part of a family that loves and cares for one another. We need to be assured that we're not in this life alone. There may be someone else who's having trouble getting their chair unfolded too. You can help each other.

On Monday March 2, 2015 the Fellowship Church at Millard, Kentucky had an impromptu worship service at 5:00pm. Dr. Ron Mann had Pastor Paddy visiting from Guatemala. He preached a powerful and challenging message on the preaching of the Gospel and its power to save and heal. He told us wonderful miracles he had seen take place within the forty mile radius that he ministers. In 2014 he and other pastors joined together and prayed for 50,000 in Guatemala. So far saved and over 45,000 had converted and been baptized.

After the message all that wanted to be healed or wanted to obey the call upon their life to minister, were given the invitation to come to the altar and be anointed with oil and prayed for.

There were thirty plus people there and all were impacted by the services. Elkhorn City, Feds Creek and Lick Creek were represented. On the way home at 9:30pm, we were rejoicing and glad we were there and wished others had been there to enjoy it as well.

Update on the progress: The Church at Millard averages 45 attending Sunday morning worship. In the past month they have had five saved and baptized. They received permission this week to connect the electricity. The church was using a generator and propane gas to heat the building.






