Those in attendance expressed how much they enjoyed the evening with the area congregations. It was truly a blessed service from the beginning to the end.



As I write this article, I am mindful of my blessings and I'm reminded that all of us are to take up our cross and follow Christ. However, as an honor to some very special people today, I want to count our losses.

Loss number one was when Rev. Bernie Lovely at age 88 went to be with the Lord. Bernie was a faithful pastor for many years who pastored in the East District at Harlan, Ashland and Morehead. He was bright, intelligent, a good reader of people and a man that was dearly loved in the Church of God congregations where he pastored. He came to know the Lord under the ministry of Cliff Hutchinson when he lived in Middletown, Ohio. His precious wife, Essie, accompanied Bernie in ministry until he went home in January of this year. Bernie was known for a sense of humor and homespun wisdom. He contributed greatly to the Church and he will be missed.

Loss number two was when Rev. Virgil Jay Harmon went to be with the Lord. Jay was 97 years old and had a dynamic ministry over the years that touched the lives of thousands as he served as both a pastor and an evangelist. Jay came to know the Lord after a near death experience as a young man and from that time forward he was a faithful and stalwart preacher and pastor in the Church of God. He and his wife, Maxine, made a lasting and positive impression on so many people. He was thoroughly familiar with the Word of God and could probably quote more poetry than most people have read. He loved horses and he loved people. Certainly Jay will be missed.

Loss number three was when Rev. Nando Mullins, Jr. went to be with the Lord. As I write this article, I just learned last evening of Bro. Junior's passing and I don't have all the details at this time. However, Bro. Nando Mullins, Jr. was a tremendous asset to the Church of God and was a long and faithful pastor to the folks in the Fedscreek First Church of God in Pike County, Kentucky. He loved the Lord, had a sweet and humble spirit about him and exemplified Christ in so many ways. He was a long term pastor to the church at Fedscreek and he made a lasting impact on the lives of so many people. His wife, Josephine was a blessing to him throughout the years. Bro. Nando Mullins, Jr. will be missed.

Up, up the long, delirious, burning blue  
I've topped the wind-swept heights with easy grace  
Where never lark, nor eer eagle flew—  
And, while with silent lifting mind I've trod

Put out my hand and touched the face of God."*
