Dear Sister Congregations of the Church of God in the East District,

One of the greatest blessings to the Church of God in the East District has been the ministry of Bro. Jeff Justice. Within the last year, Bro. Jeff has visited thirty-six churches, driven over 10 thousand miles and spent countless hours on the phone encouraging pastors and congregations. He has used his unique talents and abilities to bring people together in unity and oneness that should characterize the Church. And, it should be noted that Bro. Jeff does this on a volunteer basis and without a salary. I would not be surprised to find that Bro. Jeff donates more volunteer hours to the church than any other pastor in the Church of God Reformation Movement, and this, in spite of the fact that he works full time in a secular job.

There are two things that the East District does for Bro. Jeff. The first is that we pay his mileage expense based on the per mile basis established by the IRS. The second thing is that we established a Roth IRA for Brother Jeff to allow him to have a retirement income in the future. This was established under the guidance of the late Billy Joe Hall who understood the needs of pastors and their families and this fund should help provide some financial security for Bro. Jeff in his senior years. The IRA is funded solely by voluntary contributions from the East District Churches that are designated for that purpose.

The funding for this retirement account is through volunteer contributions from the churches in the East District. Once a year, we show our thanks and appreciation to Bro. Jeff by asking all churches that are willing and able to do so to contribute to this retirement fund. November is the month of Thanksgiving and let's let Bro. Jeff know that we're thankful for him and his ministry to the East District by being supportive.

MEADE STATION CHURCH OF GOD DEDICATES NEW MULTI-USE WORSHIP FACILITY



The Meade Station Church of God in Ashland dedicated their new multi-use worship facility on Sunday afternoon December 2. Former pastors Rev. Larry McCallister, Sr. and Rev. Orville Easterling led the congregation in the dedication of their new 19,600 square foot worship facility. The building is comprised of a multi-use area that will seat 400 people, eleven classrooms, a large library conference room, nursery, kitchen, coat room and restrooms. The Meade Station congregation purchased 43 acres in September 2003 for the purpose of relocating the church from the general site on which it had gathered in three different buildings over a period of eighty eight years. The congregation plans to retain eighteen acres of the 43 acres it originally purchased in 2003 and sell the balance of the remaining property as well as the former building and grounds it just moved from. Once that property is sold they hope to build a new 450 seat sanctuary that will attach to the building just dedicated.

The dedication service was very well attended. The Meade Station congregation desires your prayers as we move forward into new ventures of ministry.












