

What started out as an orphanage, Hope Hill is now the largest adolescent behavioral health ministry in our region. Our residential program has been successful in helping girls, ages 12-18, receive treatment for emotional and/or physical abuse, neglect, self-harming behaviors, substance use and those who are victims of human trafficking. We are dedicated to providing a loving caring home for God's children and they have opportunities to connect and learn about God through attending weekly off campus church services, summer church programs, chapel services and a weekly Bible study with a local pastor.


