MEADE STATION CHURCH OF GOD IS MOVING!

That's right; with the Lord's help the Meade Station Church of God will be moving this October. The move will be a short one in regards to distance, only a few hundred yards from their present location, but it will be huge in regards to the prospects for future ministry.

Many members of the Meade Station congregation dreamed for years that the congregation could move from the hillside where they have been located for over forty years and move into facilities that were more accessible and spacious. With God's help this dream is about to come to fruition.

In reality this move has been in process since July 3, 2003. It was on that day that an agreement was reached on the purchase of 43 acres of property located across Marsh Hill Drive from the current worship facility. Much study, planning and prayer has gone into this current building project. The building now under construction is a multiuse facility comprised of nearly 20,000 square feet. It will house a temporary sanctuary that will seat 400 people plus office and classroom facilities that will enhance the future ministries of the congregation. Once the current worship facilities can be sold, plus an additional 17 acres the congregation wishes to sell, the second phase of construction will begin which will house the permanent sanctuary as well as additional ministry areas. The temporary sanctuary now under construction will become the permanent gym/fellowship area. When all is said and done the congregation hopes to retain approximately 18 acres of the original property that was purchased in 2003. A beautiful shelter house, complete with restrooms, was built on the property some time ago.

A service of dedication is tentatively scheduled for **December 2, 2012**. Former pastors Larry McCallister, Sr. and Orville Easterling will be leading the congregation in a service of dedication. All congregations of the Church of God are invited to attend.

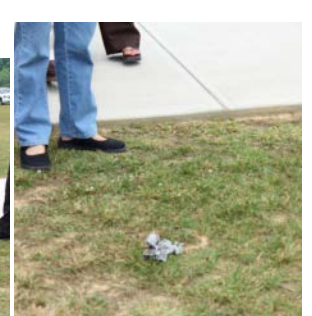
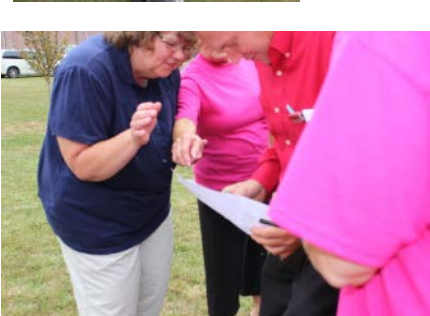

Everyone enjoyed a wonderful day of celebrating the blessings of God! And the great commission will continue as the First Church of God of Jackson reaches out to a lost and hurting community with hands of fellowship and love and welcomes them into the Family of God.

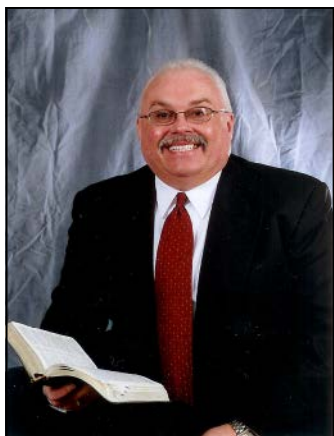

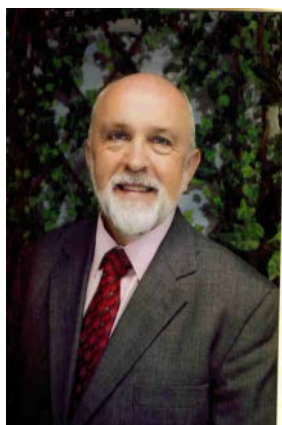

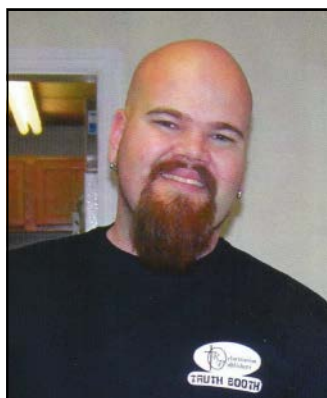
