

## From the Desk of the East District Church of God Vice Chairman

Dear Families and Friends of the East District,

Let me begin my article this month by thanking all of you who attended the rally service at Owingsville. We were so honored and blessed by your presence with us and we truly appreciate the effort that you put forth to be there. And, this appreciation is only matched by the anticipation we have of many great and wonderful rally experiences in the future. It is obvious that we have many people who love the Church of God beyond the four walls of the local congregation and see a greater vision of what we can do together.

As we enter the summer months, let me use this time to reflect on some of the important events that are either now in progress or coming up soon.

The first thing I want to emphasize is attendance at the summer youth camps at Camp Lyons. Church Camp can be one of the most positive influences on a young person's life and it is an investment that can make a real difference in their future. It's not an expense, it's an investment in the future of young people. You can go to [www.kycog.org](http://www.kycog.org) and get an application if you don't already have one. A lifetime of memories are created at church camp and many young people have been saved, called to Christian service and developed friendships that remain over the years.

Secondly, I want to urge church congregations to consider giving camp scholarships to young people who might not be able to afford camp. What better investment could you make in the spiritual development of a child? Some of you probably have children in your church whose parents are unwilling or unable to make this investment but would allow the church to do so through a scholarship. Please consider making a difference in the life of a child by sending a kid to camp! Time is running short before camp begins, so act quickly.

Thirdly, we are making a bold attempt to make Camp Lyons debt free by the state minister's meeting in Richmond, Kentucky in September. Over the last two years we have reduced the indebtedness from circa 131,000 dollars to just over 22,000 dollars today. As we go down the home stretch, please consider a love offering or special fund raising project to help us achieve victory. Once the debt is paid, we will not be saddled with a 1000 dollars per month payment and we can make some improvements to the camp that will make it a place that provides even greater ministry.

Fourthly, please be supportive of our camp meetings this summer. The first one will be Camargo Camp Meeting which will convene on July 15 through July 22. Rev. Allan Hutchinson, pastor of the Morehead First Church of God will be the evangelist and the camp meeting will provide an abundance of sound preaching, excellent singing and wonderful fellowship. Add to that the ice cream made available by the Camargo Youth Group and you've got the makings of a very good time!

And finally, I want to recognize two people who have done above and beyond the call of duty to promote the East District and Camp Lyons. Rev. Jeff Justice has worked so hard to promote unity in eastern Kentucky and his ministry to us is certainly worthy of note. Thanks Jeff for all of your efforts that are producing exceptional results. Also, very special thanks are in order to Rev. Steve Williams who has worked so hard at promoting the debt retirement project and improvement projects for Camp Lyons. Steve has a very special burden for Camp Lyons because it was there that he accepted his call to ministry and he knows the spiritual value of the camp. These two men have made an exceptional difference!

Thanks to all of you who contribute to the ministry of the Church of God in Kentucky and the East District. May the Lord bless you, guide you, keep you and hold you in the hollow of His hand. Have a great summer!

## Four Seasons Christian Center at CAMP LYONS Update

We have exciting news to report: Morehead First redirected their \$4,500 gift from maintenance to debt retirement. With the matching money of Kentucky Ministries, this donation lowers our loan balance at the Salt Lick Bank from \$22,000 to \$13,000! Can you believe we are this close? The camp board hopes to stand before the State General Assembly in Richmond in September to burn the mortgage of Camp Lyons. We will own our camp debt-free! Praise the Lord.

We need your help! Our matching funds are nearly exhausted. Can you--will your congregation--help? Chairman Lowell C. Rice set July 1, 2012 as a special INDEPENDENCE DAY OFFERING to free Camp Lyons of all debt. Will you collect a love offering Sunday, July 1, to retire the camp debt?

Thank you for your tremendous response to date! Following our 2010 GA, we began this campaign with a \$120,000 loan balance. Together, we have erased \$100,000 of debt! Victory is in sight. Family Camp begins today and the camp stands ready. Family Camp Director Pat Davis represented the Board of Christian Education last night at our camp board meeting. She commended the camp board and staff for how well the camp looked. We had one deficiency and that has been resolved, thanks to Sister Libby Tedder from Campbellsville. The Board thanks the staff for working so hard to prepare the camp for the campers.

Basketball Goal (Donated by Caretaker Chuck Riddel)  
Black Sealer for Basketball Court (???)  
Breaker Box for Men's Bath House (???)--(Labor donated by Bro. James Reynolds)

The state treasurer has \$0 dollars available for the above necessary expenses, so we really need your help.

Flat-Screen TV with DVD for KDC building (**\$1,200**)  
Washer and Dryer (**\$1,000**)  
Road Signs (**\$250**)
