Small Animal Project for Gitalama, Rwanda

Project Number: 42.30490

The **state project for 2012-13 is the Small Animal Project for Gitalama, Rwanda in the amount of \$5,000.** This project will provide male goats, cows, tin roofs for chicken houses and bee hive containers for this area. The cost of the above is as follows: male goats-\$175 each, cows-\$700 each, tin roof for chicken houses-\$320 each, and bee hive containers-\$100 each.

The products from these animals provide food for the families and a means of support so the families can buy other needed items. The off spring from the animals are sold to other families and the cycle begins again. This is a paying forward project for the area. It would be wonderful if we could raise the total amount of \$5,000. We have not reached the total amount for our state project in several years. Maybe your group could select a specific item or two and work toward raising the total amount for those you have chosen. Some money making ideas are: bake sales, yard sales, dinner after church on Sunday, dessert after church on Sunday night or Wednesday night, supper on Saturday night, breakfast on Saturday morning, auctions, sell candy, sell cookbooks and craft sales. I am sure your group has other ideas as well.

Working together we will be able to reach our goal.

Jeff in his senior years. The IRA is funded solely by voluntary contributions from the East District Churches that are designated for that purpose.

The funding for this retirement account is through volunteer contributions from the churches in the East District. Once a year, we show our thanks and appreciation to Bro. Jeff by asking all churches that are willing and able to do so to contribute to this retirement fund. November is the month of Thanksgiving and let's let Bro. Jeff know that we're thankful for him and his ministry to the East District by being supportive.


