The law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:24 - 26

I have always loved reading and bible study and I always can learn or understand the scriptures better no matter how many times I hear or read them. While studying the book of Daniel I learned that life lessons are different than when I went to school.

The teacher taught me the material and then gave me the test to see how well I learned the lesson. In life, especially my spiritual life, I take the test to learn the lesson. Because one day there will be a Final Test: I Cor. 3:13 Everyone's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try everyone's work of what sort it is.

As I read in Daniel 1. Judah has been taken to Babylon.

Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah have been chosen by the king to learn the way of life and the language of the Chaldeans for a span of three years. Their names were changed and the king gave them different food; his meat to eat and his wine to drink.

In verse 8: Daniel purposed in his heart not to defile himself with what the king offered.

To live a clean and holy life always requires faith and courage. Daniel's decision influenced Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego. Daniel had enough confidence in God to say in verse 12: Prove thy servants for ten days, just give us herbs and water to drink.

As a result of this test of faith and obedience, Daniel and his friends were healthier than the others. Because of their convictions and consistent lives, God gave these four faithful young men knowledge, skill in learning and wisdom and gave Daniel understanding in all visions and dreams.

At the end of the three years when they stood before the king, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers that were in his realm.

What I learned from these four young men: Sometimes God saves us from the fire -He helps us avoid the fire. Sometimes God saves us through the fire -He walks with us, and sometimes God saves us by the fire to save us and others.

A. After the testing is sure to follow a testimony. (Daniel 1)

B. God walks with me through the fire and burns off everything that binds me or ties me down. Sets me free. (Daniel 3)

C. When I am doing the right thing there are still going to be people angry with me. People of faith are not always popular. (Daniel 6)

D. God is more interested in my character than my comfort. (Daniel 1,3,6)

E. My loyalty is to God. (Daniel 3, 6)



FAITH PROVING TRUE UNDER FIRE - THE PURPOSE OF THE LAW (CONT.)

After the three Hebrew Children let the king know that they would not bow down and serve and worship his gods or his golden image. Their testimony stood the test as they were cast into the fiery furnace those that looked upon them saw that the fire had no power.

In Daniel 3: 28 King Nebuchadnezzar said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent his angel and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God. By the king's own words "there is no other God that can deliver after this sort.

Daniel chapter 6 relates to us the story of how King Darius puts Daniel first because he saw that Daniel was different. There was an excellent spirit within him. Daniel was a man of faith and prayer. Faith always finds help in prayer. King Darius sent Daniel to the lion's den because he kept on praying as he did before the decree, that stated petitions only be to the king for thirty days. In verse 23 we read Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God. King Darius made a decree that in every dominion of his kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and steadfast for ever; and his kingdom which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end. He delivers and rescues and works signs and wonders in heaven and in earth who has delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.

I know there have to be rules and the rules are made to be followed but when the instructions and rules are not in line with me faithfully serving and worshiping God; I have to ask myself this question; Will my faith hold up when hard choices have to made? The answer is yes it will because God always has the way for us by His Power, His Spirit and His Word.

I Peter 1:3-9 Blessed is the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the Dead, To an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, Who are kept by the Power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time wherein ye greatly rejoice though now for a season, if need be ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of Gold that perisheth though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen ye love in whom though now ye see him not, yet believing ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: Receiving the end of your faith even the salvation of your soul
