Fourth Of July + A Tree In The Cemetery = A New Song.
Confused yet?

Two well-known writers in the Church of God movement teamed up on this song that first appeared in 1923 in the "Reformation Glory" songbook, "I'm On The Winning Side."

Andrew Byers recalls, "I listened to a brother preach who said something about being on the winning side. Instantly this suggested itself as a title for a song." He sent the "hook line" to Charles Naylor who wrote the words. When finished he sent it back to Byers who wrote the tune to it sitting under a tree in a cemetery on the 4th of July.

This song with a triumphant March beat victoriously proclaims "Though hot may be the fray, My soul can boldly say, I'm on the winning side with Jesus."

So next time your sitting under a tree in a cemetery on the Fourth Of July, be sure to have a pen and paper. You never know when the Lord will give you a song!

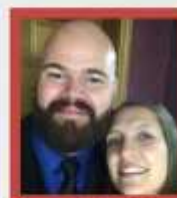
