Greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

We have come through the Easter season once again. The season that reminds us of the resurrection of our Lord. It was his appearances to his disciples after the resurrection, that "fired" them up.

Seeing and touching and listening to the risen Savior was a turning point in the lives of the disciples. Prior to the resurrection, they appeared timid and reserved in their ministry. They were concerned about the power and authority of the Sanhedrin and the Romans, fearful for their lives. The prime example of that was Peter's denial of knowing Jesus when he was confronted during Jesus' trial.

However, after meeting the risen Christ, everything seemed to change for them. Their fear of the authorities seemed to vanish. We see Peter and John hauled before the Sanhedrin, and threatened, to no avail. Then the next time they were whipped. Still, they refused to back down or shut up preaching about Jesus. Then we see Stephen stoned to death and James put to the sword. Even then the apostles and disciples continued to defy the authorities and ceased not to teach and preach about Jesus and his resurrection.

It almost seemed that the disciples developed a death wish. As if they were eager to die, and move on into eternity. The apostle Paul would later write and say "FOR ME TO LIVE IS CHRIST", and "TO DIE IS GAIN!"

Meeting the risen Christ removed all their doubts about life after death. Hearing him talk about heaven and what was in store for them on "the other side" filled them with eagerness to reach heaven.

When I am assailed by doubts and confusion, I turn my thoughts back to the resurrection, the most significant event in all of human history. That brings me back to the ground zero, to the corner stone of my faith. The resurrection re-energizes, my desire to continue to serve.

Because he lives, I can face tomorrow! Thank God for the resurrection of His son. Spring is the season of new life — picturing for us, our new life in Christ and the new life to come on the other side of the grave. Indeed, for me to live is Christ, and to die, is gain!

Let us keep Christ's resurrection foremost in our thoughts. It can transform us as it did the disciples.
